CITY OPENS SUMMER JOBS TO STUDENTS

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The City of Killeen is accepting applications for dozens of summer jobs.

Job opportunities include lifeguards, water safety instructors and cashiers at the Family Aquatics Center. The City will also be hiring grounds maintenance, drainage and recycling workers.

Each year, the city staff expands to keep up with the demands of summer programs. The schedule for most summer hire jobs coincides with Killeen Independent School District school calendar.

“Summer hires are integral to providing residents with top notch service during the summer months,” said Brett Williams, executive director of community services. “Without these hires, it would be impossible for us to conduct our aquatics operations or to keep our parks, pavilions and playgrounds in great condition during our busiest time of the year.”
