COMMUNITY PLANNING MEETINGS SCHEDULED

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The Community Development Advisory Committee and Community Development Department will begin planning the FY 2017-2018 program year at community planning meetings in February.

Killeen residents are invited to become involved in the community development process. Participants will discuss needs and submit comments to identify and prioritize housing, health, social service, employment and education needs of Killeen renters and owners, persons with disabilities, veterans including their families, homeless, formerly homeless, at-risk of homelessness families and individuals, victims of abuse and domestic violence, persons with HIV/AIDS, elderly and extremely low- to moderate-income persons.

The community planning meetings are part of the general requirements from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grant programs to encourage and involve residents, including persons of predominantly low and moderate-income neighborhoods, in the development of the annual action plan for funding of programs and activities to benefit the Killeen community.
