Mayor Cospers gave the invocation, and Councilmember Fleming led everyone in the pledge of allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Moore to approve the agenda as written. Motion seconded by Councilmember Okray. The motion carried 5 to 0.

Ordinances

OR-16-006 Consider an ordinance canvassing the returns and declaring results of May 7, 2016, General Election.

The City Secretary read the caption of the ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 7, 2016 FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND THREE COUNCIL MEMBERS-AT-LARGE.

Prior to the meeting Mayor Pro-Tem Moore, Councilmember Kilpatrick, and Councilmember Fleming verified the results of the May 7th election. Mayor Pro-Tem Moore read the ordinance that certified the election results, stating the number of votes each candidate received and that Jose Segarra was elected Mayor, Gregory Johnson, Jonathan Okray, and Juan Rivera were elected Council Members-At-Large.

Motion was made by Councilmember Rivera to approve OR-16-006. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Kilpatrick. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Special Recognitions

Mayor Cospers thanked the citizens of Killeen for the opportunity to serve them, thanked the community leaders, and the outgoing council members for their service and dedication to the city.

Oath of Office & Certification of Election

The City Secretary administered the Oath to Jose Segarra, Gregory Johnson, Jonathan Okray, and Juan Rivera. Mayor Cospers presented the Certification of Election.

Standards of Conduct

The Interim City Manager, Lillian Ann Farris, read the Standards of Conduct while the entire new council signed the document.

Call to Order and Roll Call

The new council was seated at the Dias. Mayor Segarra called the meeting to order and took roll call, noting that each councilmember was present.

Resolutions

RS-16-053 Consider a memorandum/resolution designating a Mayor Pro-Tem.

Councilmember Fleming nominated Councilmember Brockley Moore for Mayor Pro-Tem, seconded by Councilmember Okray. With no other nominations, Mayor Segarra asked for a vote to appoint Councilmember Moore as Mayor Pro-Tem. Motion carried 6 to 0.

With no further business, upon motion being made by Councilmember Rivera, seconded by Councilmember Kilpatrick, and unanimously approved, the meeting was adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
