STARBURST JUNIOR GOLF CLASSIC COMING TO KILLEEN

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): Killeen's Stonetree Golf Club is hosting 600 youth golfers during the annual Starburst Junior Golf Classic today through Wednesday. This is the eighth time Killeen has hosted the 19-year event.

Golfers are boys and girls ages seven to 18 competing in various age categories and at four different golf courses during the three-day tournament. Competitors are primarily from the United States but some hail from other countries.

"Stonetree's facilities and course condition were major factors in our selection," says Brad Baine, Stonetree's director. "The City of Killeen has a tremendous asset in our golf course."

In order to accommodate the competition, Stonetree will be closed Tuesday until 3 p.m. and the entire day Wednesday.
