KILLEEN CITIZENS ACADEMIES ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The City of Killeen is now accepting applications for the third Killeen Citizens Academy and the 39th Citizens Police Academy.

The Fall 2016 Killeen Citizens Academy is a nine-week session scheduled September 7 through November 2. Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings from 6 to 8:30 p.m. at various city locations.

Each class will detail a different department, function or program of city government. Participants will interact with elected officials and city staff and get an inside look at city operations.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and may not be running for political office during the session. Residents of Killeen and Fort Hood will be given priority enrollment.

Applications and detailed information are available online at www.killeentexas.gov. Participants must complete the Killeen Citizens Academy Application and submit it by August 5. There is no cost to apply or participate.

The 39th Citizens Police Academy is also accepting applications now through September 9 for its fall session.

The Citizens Police Academy is a 12-week session scheduled September 19 through November 28 on Monday evenings from 7 to 10 p.m.

Classes cover topics from administration to operation to investigation and give participants opportunities to meet and interact with police personnel.

There is no cost to apply or participate, but applicants must complete an application form and agree to a background check with criminal history inquiry. Applications are available by contacting Tammy Moseley at 501-8805 or tmoseley@killeentexas.gov.
