## **KILLEEN COMMUNITY CENTER BEING USED AS EMERGENCY SHELTER FOR HURRICANE EVACUEES**

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The City of Killeen has accepted Hurricane Harvey evacuees from Brazoria County at our emergency shelter located at Killeen Community Center. Shelter operations will continue indefinitely.

Killeen Community Center and Bob Gilmore Senior Center will not operate normally until shelter operations are discontinued.

The shelter is currently accepting new, unopened personal hygiene item donations including feminine care products and toiletries. Those items can be dropped off at Killeen Community Center, 2201 E. Veterans Memorial Boulevard.
