CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE TO END

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): Killeen's curbside recycling service will end September 30. No new customers are being accepted.

Residents are still able to recycle at the Killeen Recycling Center. Materials accepted include #1 and #2 plastics, all types of paper, cardboard, steel, tin and aluminum cans, clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, cell phones and rechargeable batteries.

The center also offers used cooking oil and automotive oil recycling to residents.

The Killeen Recycling Center is located downtown at 111 E. Avenue F. Its hours are Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Wednesday and Thursday from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. It is also open on even-dated Saturdays from 8 a.m. to noon.
