




## Population/Crime Rate Comparison





# Crime Rate Recap

- ❖ Compared to 2014, the crime rate in 2015 continued to decline
  - Overall crime rate decreased 13.3%
  - Violent crime rate increased 0.8%
  - Non-violent crime rate fell 15.8%
- ❖ Since 2010, the overall crime rate has decreased 34.8%
  - Violent crime rate fell 20.9%
  - Non-violent crime rate declined 37.2%
