Water Off Tomorrow - Boil Water Notice Issued

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The water will be off tomorrow between 8 a.m. and noon for residences and businesses in the following areas:

Bryce Avenue, from South 2nd Street to Gray Street
Collins Avenue, from Bryce Avenue to Trimmier Road
8th Street, from Collins Avenue to Fowler Avenue

City crews will be replacing a valve and must turn off the water in the area to complete the work. Service will be restored tomorrow evening.

Residents in the affected area will be notified of the outage in person or by door hangers, and should prepare for the outage by storing drinking water for people and pets.

This outage is part of an ongoing program to repair and upgrade the water distribution system. The program includes critical replacements and repairs. Limited water outages are necessary to perform the maintenance which will result in improved water quality and services.

The city of Killeen apologizes for any inconvenience caused by this outage and appreciates your patience.

A **BOIL WATER NOTICE** will go into effect at 8 a.m. tomorrow for residents in the affected areas.

Residents are cautioned to **BOIL ALL WATER BEFORE CONSUMING.** Residents will be notified when the boil water notice has been lifted.

Boil Water Notice:

Due to conditions caused by maintenance of the water system, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires the city of Killeen, PWS 0140006, to notify all customers in the above listed area to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and for making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you.
