Killeen Police are investigating an Aggravated Robbery that occurred in the 1200 block of N. 4th St. on Saturday, January 16, 2010, just after 8:00pm.

Officers responded to 1217 N. 4th St. on Saturday, January 16, 2010, at approximately 8:15pm in reference to a shooting that had just occurred. The officers arrived at the residence to find the gunshot victim had been transported to the Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center by a private vehicle. Officers responded to Darnall and began speaking to the people who were inside the residence when the shooting occurred. The witnesses told the officers that they were inside playing games when they heard a knock at the door. One of the people opened the door and two black males entered. The two black males approached the victim and shot him; they then stole some items inside the residence and fled the area. One suspect is described as 5'7" tall and weighing approximately 158 pounds, he was wearing a red hat, a white shirt and a Nascar racing jacket with the Crown Royal logo on it. The other suspect is described as 5'8" tall and weighing approximately 165 pounds, he was wearing a black stalking cap, a black shirt and dark jeans. Both suspects were armed.

The victim was subsequently transferred to Scott & White Memorial Hospital where he underwent surgery and is in stable condition.
