Killeen Police are investigating a fatal one car accident that occurred early this morning in the 4900 block of E. Veteran's Memorial Blvd.

Officers responded to the 4900 block of E. Veteran's Memorial Blvd at approximately 1:45am on Sunday, January 17, 2010, to investigate the report of a single vehicle accident; officers arrived to find a white Ford Crown Victoria that had crashed. The preliminary accident investigators information revealed that the vehicle that was occupied by five Killeen men was traveling westbound in the 5100 block of E. Veteran's Memorial Blvd when the vehicle left the roadway and spun out of control subsequently striking a tree with the left side of the vehicle. The 22 year old right rear passenger and the 22 year old driver were both ejected from the vehicle. The driver and the middle back seat passenger were transported to the Carl R. Darnell Army Medical Center with non life threatening injuries. The 20 year old front seat passenger was airlifted to Scott & White Memorial Hospital in critical condition. Justice of the Peace Garland Potvin pronounced Al Winfield, the right rear passenger and 21 year old David Burnell, the left rear passenger, deceased at the scene; he ordered autopsies to be performed at the Southwestern Institute of Forensic Sciences in Dallas.

It is unknown at this time what caused the vehicle to leave the roadway. This accident continues to be investigated and information will be released as it becomes available.
