Killeen Police are investigating several Aggravated Robberies of businesses that have occurred recently involving armed males wearing dark clothing.

Officers responded to the following Aggravated Robberies between Monday, January 25, 2010 and Wednesday, January 27, 2010.

Golden Chick Restaurant – 1600 S. Fort Hood St. - Tuesday, January 26, 2010 – 8:15pm

Star Mart – 2901 W. Elms – Tuesday, January 26, 2010 – 9:30pm

Super Quick Mart #3 – 3101 W. Stan Schlueter Loop – Tuesday, January 26, 2010 – 9:40pm

Star Mart Grocery – 4002 Watercrest Rd. – Tuesday, January 26, 2010 – 11:05pm

Mickeys Convenience Store – 902 W. Jasper – Wednesday, January 27, 2010 – 6:16am

The suspect(s) in these robberies were said to be one or two armed light skinned black or Hispanic males wearing dark clothing and at one point a silver vehicle was described as a possible suspect vehicle.

An officer was patrolling in the area of Anna Lee and Old 440 and noticed a silver vehicle sitting behind the Mickey's Convenience Store; the vehicle was occupied by 3 males who were acting suspicious. The officer attempted to stop and speak with the occupants when the driver fled with the vehicle and a pursuit ensued. The vehicle stopped in the 1400 block of Karen, the officer had the three males at gunpoint when two of the males fled on foot. One subject was taken into custody. One of the males that ran was located at Tallwood Dr. and Elms Rd.; the other male that ran was located in the backyard of a residence in the 3800 block of Tallwood Dr. All three males were taken into custody and charged with Evading Arrest; they were transported to the Killeen City Jail.

There is a possibility that these robberies are related, but more investigation is needed to make that determination. Further information will be released as it becomes available.
