Killeen Police arrested two Killeen men on Thursday, February 18, 2010 for burglarizing a residence in the 2800 block of Cedar Circle.

Officers responded to 2834 Cedar Circle at 11:09am after receiving a 911 call advising two black males were burglarizing an apartment. The officers arrived to find the back door to the apartment open and items missing. Witnesses told the officers the suspects backed a white Chevrolet Caprice up to the back door and loaded items into the trunk and left. The owner arrived to identify what was missing from the apartment.

The officers were given the license plate of the vehicle and went to the owner's residence in the 1000 block of Shofner Dr. As the officers were in the area on Shofner they saw the vehicle, occupied by three black males, pulling into the driveway of 1021 Shofner. The officers arrived and began speaking with the males who had gotten out of the vehicle and were now on the front porch of the residence. The owner allowed the officers to search the vehicle; they located the stolen items from Cedar Circle in the trunk of the white Chevrolet Caprice. The two males also fit the description of the suspects who were seen at the apartment on Cedar Circle.

On Friday, February 19, 2010, this case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office and a complaint was returned charging 23 year old Joshua Leonard Davis and 20 year old Mario Gadson II with Burglary of a Habitation. Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke set their bond at \$50,000 each; they have been transferred to the Bell County Jail.
