Killeen Police arrested a 35 year old Killeen man and finding stolen property from recent burglaries that had occurred in the 800 block of Pecan Circle.

Killeen Police received a Crime Stoppers Tip on Thursday, April 15, 2010, giving information about burglaries that had occurred in the 800 block of Pecan Circle. Detectives were given the information and found that three burglaries had occurred within the past few days in the 800 block of Pecan Circle. The detectives went to 800 Pecan Circle #B to serve an arrest warrant on a male; when he was taken into custody officers located a stolen cell phone from one of the recent burglaries. Detectives obtained a search warrant; during the execution of the search warrant numerous stolen items that were reported from the previous burglaries, were located inside the residence.

This case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office on Friday, April 16, 2010 and a complaint was returned charging Daniel Crayton Jr. with Burglary of a Habitation and Possession of a Controlled Substance. He was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke who set his bond at \$75,000 for the Burglary charge and \$20,000 for the Possession charge; he is currently in the Bell County Jail.

Approximately \$9,500 worth of stolen property was returned to the victims of these burglaries.
