A Killeen Fire lieutenant recovered a newborn baby girl from the Killeen Central Fire Station Academy front lawn located at 207 N. 28th St. today, April 29, 2010, just after 2:00pm.

A lieutenant with the Killeen Fire Department heard a noise by the window sill outside his office when he went outside to find a newborn baby girl wrapped in a blue hooded jacket. He immediately took the baby inside and paramedics transported her to Metroplex Hospital. Once at the hospital the baby was assessed by medical personnel at the emergency room and appears to be in good condition.



It is believed the baby was approximately 2 hours old when she was abandoned. She weighs 6 pounds and 3 ½ ounces and is 18 inches long; she appears to be of a Hispanic origin. She has been admitted to Metroplex Hospital and will remain there until released by medical personnel to the Department of Family and Protective Services; Child Protective Services.

Detectives are asking anyone who may have information about this baby or the mother of the child to call the Killeen Police Department at 501-8800. An anonymous call or email can be given to Crime Stoppers at 526-TIPS (8477) or online at www.killeencrimestoppers.com. The information will be confidential and no one will know who called or emailed.

We are also concerned for the mother of the child; she could be at risk of infection or illness if she does not seek medical attention soon.

Detectives continue to investigate this case and information will be released as it becomes available.
