Killeen Police need assistance in locating a Killeen woman who is wanted for Debit Card Abuse.

Officers were contacted by a female advising that her debit card had been used on several occasions after she lost her wallet in the 3300 block of S. Fort Hood St. on Sunday, April 4, 2010.

Detectives were able to identify the suspect through security videos at the locations she used the victim's debit card. This case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office and a complaint was issued charging Talea Danielle Mack with Debit Card Abuse. Justice of the Peace Garland Potvin issued a warrant for her arrest on May 4, 2010.

Talea is a 26 year old black female, with a dark complexion, 5'5" tall and weighs approximately 220 pounds. She was last known to live at 305 Elms Rd. but has not been seen since this warrant was issued. She is also wanted for a similar warrant with the Harker Heights Police Department.
