Killeen Police are investigating the shooting death of a 19 year old Killeen man in the parking lot of the Putt Putt Golf and Games on Wednesday, June 23, 2010.

Officers responded to a report of a shooting at 2508 Cross Drive, Putt Putt Golf and Games, in the parking lot at 10:45pm. Upon their arrival they found the victim that had been shot inside a vehicle. Witnesses advised that while the victim and a female were sitting in their vehicle unknown males approached, one male began speaking with the victim and a disagreement ensued and the male was shot. The suspects left the area in an unknown vehicle. The female received minor injuries; she was transported to Scott & White Memorial Hospital where she was treated and released.

Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke pronounced the victim deceased at 11:15pm and ordered an autopsy to be performed at the Southwestern Institute of Forensic Sciences in Dallas. The victim's name has been withheld due to investigative reasons.

UPDATE: June 26, 2010

During the course of the investigation it was determined who was responsible for the death of Jaytuan Lee Hawthorne at Putt Putt Golf and Games. The case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office on Friday, June 25, 2010, and complaints were returned charging 19 year old James Lee Garris and 19 year old Adrian Maxwell Lee with Murder. Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke issued warrants for their arrest.

On Friday, June 25, 2010 at approximately 5:00pm, James Lee Garris was arrested without incident in the 1300 block of Pershing Drive.

Adrian Maxwell Lee has not been apprehended. He is described as a 19 year old black male with black hair and brown eyes; he is 5'7" tall and weighs approximately 160 pounds. He is **CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS**. Do not attempt to apprehend him.

This continues to be investigated and information will be released as it becomes available.
