Killeen Police arrested a 25 year old Killeen man on Thursday, August 12, 2010 for an outstanding Burglary warrant.

On Monday, August 9, 2010 at approximately 9:45am, officers responded to 2810 Lake Rd. in reference to a Burglary of a Habitation; the resident came home to find the front door kicked in and items missing from the apartment. As officers were speaking to the victim they received information from witnesses who saw the suspect leaving the apartment with the victim's property. Through the investigation it was determined who the suspect was and where he lived. The officers went to the suspect's residence and located him and the stolen items inside his house. He was detained and later taken into custody when witnesses identified him as the person responsible for the burglary at 2810 Lake Rd. He was transported to the Killeen City Jail. On August 10, 2010, the suspect was released pending further investigation into the burglary.

Detectives continued to investigate the burglary at 2810 Lake Rd.; during the investigation it was found that the suspect was also responsible for numerous other burglaries in Killeen. On Thursday, August 12, 2010, these cases were reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office and a complaint charging Jacky Lee Baker Jr. with Burglary of a Habitation was returned and Justice of the Peace Garland Potvin issued a warrant for his arrest. Baker was officially charged with the burglary that occurred at 2810 Lake Rd. but is known to be involved in at least 14 other burglaries. Baker is currently in the Bell County Jail with a \$75,000 bond.
