Killeen Police have arrested a 22 year old Fort Hood soldier for Aggravated Sexual Assault on Sunday, August 22, 2010.

Officers responded to a report of an assault that occurred in an apartment complex laundry room on Sunday, August 22, 2010 at approximately 10:30am. The officers were given the description of the suspect and the vehicle he fled the area with. As the officers were responding to the area, another officer advised a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle passed them on Old 440. The officer turned around and found the vehicle unoccupied in the 4200 block of Old 440. While the officers were searching the area they located a black male matching the description of the suspect; when he saw the officers he fled on foot and a pursuit ensued. The male was hiding behind a privacy fence in the 1300 block of Cavalry when he was located by a K9 Officer. The officer identified himself and his police K9 to the suspect; he was ordered to lay down on the ground with his hands visible or risk being bitten by the K9. Instead of complying with the officers orders the suspect continued to back away. He was again ordered by the officer to lay down with his hands showing but the suspect continued to flee at a quicker pace. The suspect was then apprehended by the police K9 and the officer. He was transported to the Killeen City Jail.

The name and photo of the suspect have been withheld pending further investigation and a review by the Bell County District Attorney's Office.

Update – 08/24/2010



The Bell County District Attorney's Office has reviewed three cases from this past weekend; complaints were returned charging Bradric G. D. Fransaw with two counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault and another complaint was returned charging Fransaw with one count of Aggravated Assault. He is currently in the Killeen City Jail awaiting arraignment. While detectives have linked Fransaw to the other five assaults in Killeen they continue to investigate these cases. Further charges are pending until these cases are reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's office. This investigation has also linked Fransaw to the sexual assault that occurred in Copperas Cove.
