Killeen Police and U.S. Marshals Task Force arrested a wanted man after a short standoff, today, Thursday, September 16, 2010.

Killeen Officers were assisting the United States Marshals Task Force in attempting to serve felony warrants on a 22 year old man who was wanted for two counts of Aggravated Robbery out of Beaumont, TX and one federal warrant for Unlawful Flight to Avoid Prosecution. Killeen officers were attempting to stop a vehicle at 48th St. and Veteran's Memorial Blvd that was possibly occupied by the suspect when a black male jumped from the vehicle before it stopped and began fleeing from the officers on foot. A pursuit ensued and the male fled inside a house in the 500 block of 58th St. Members of the task force and Killeen officers surrounded the house and deployed the Tactical Response Unit just before 12 noon. The TRU responded and surrounded the house; a short time later two black males exited the residence separately and were detained. One of the males was the wanted suspect Terry Lynn Adams; he was taken into custody at 12:48pm and transported to the Killeen City Jail. He will be transferred to the Bell County Jail after he is arraigned on Friday, September 17, 2010. The other male, the suspects brother, was released no charges.
