Killeen Police arrested a 27 year old Killeen man after he stabbed a female today, Tuesday, September 28, 2010 just before 8:00am.

Officers responded to a 911 call from a neighbor of a female who lives at 2300 Andover when they heard what they believed was a domestic dispute in apartment #6. Upon the officer's arrival he spoke with the neighbor and approached the apartment but did not hear anything. The officer knocked on the door several times but received no response from inside. The officer was looking through a window saw a black male enter the living room; the officer asked the male where the female resident was and he told the officer she left; the officer told the male to open the door but he refused and left the room. The officer continued to knock on the door and then heard a female screaming and heard what he believed was the female being assaulted. The officer then kicked open the door to find the black male armed with a large knife and blood on both the male and female. The male suspect then fled the apartment on foot still armed with the knife and the officer gave chase. The suspect was taken into custody in the 1000 block of Bonner Drive attempting to hide from the officer behind a shed; the male was transported to the Killeen City Jail.

The 22 year old female victim was transported to Metroplex Hospital with several cuts to the face and a stab wound to the chest and later transferred to Scott & White Memorial Hospital where she remains in stable condition.

This case will be reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office; until then the name of the male has been withheld until formal charges have been returned.
