The Killeen Police Department Traffic Unit will be conducting a Special Traffic Enforcement Operation on Thursday, October 7, 2010, throughout the day.

This operation will take place at the 3470 off ramp from eastbound 190. This intersection has become a traffic complaint area in which drivers on Central Texas Expressway are not yielding the right of way to vehicles exiting 190. Crashes have occurred in this area and this operation has been completed in the past.

The Texas State Transportation Code Section 545.154 - Vehicle Entering or leaving Limited-Access or Controlled Access Highway.

**An operator on an access or feeder road of a limited-access or controlled-access highway shall yield the right-of-way to a vehicle entering or about to enter the access or feeder road from the highway or leaving or about to leave the access or feeder road to enter the highway.**

This operation's objective is to enforce failure to yield right of way – yield sign violations and to inform the citizens of the actual violation and create awareness of the actual law – Failure to Yield Right of Way – Yield Sign.

The Traffic Unit conducts these special operations frequently to educate the citizens and to reduce traffic accidents within the city.
