Killeen Police arrested two Killeen men early Tuesday morning, October 12, 2010, for burglarizing a residence and several vehicles in the south east area of Killeen.

Officers were notified at approximately 4:00am by a victim advising their vehicle had just been burglarized and two suspicious males wearing backpacks had been seen in the area lifting car door handles. Officers responded to the area and began searching for the suspicious males.

Just after 5:00am, officers saw two males matching the description of the suspicious males reported earlier, walking through the parking lot of the McDonald's in the 4300 block of E. CTE and made contact with them. After speaking with the males and further investigation, it was determined these two were the suspected car burglars as well as the suspects in a house burglary; they were taken into custody and transported to the Killeen City Jail.

The house burglary case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office and a complaint was returned charging 24 year old Glenell Laroy Drake and 19 year old Keaven Nathual Murphy with Burglary of a Habitation. These suspects were also charged with seven counts of Burglary of a Motor Vehicle. Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke set their bonds at \$50,000 each for the Burglary of a Habitation and \$5,000 for each Burglary of a Motor Vehicle charge, totaling \$85,000 in bonds. Both suspects will be transferred to the Bell County Jail later today.

It was determined that these burglars targeted unlocked motor vehicles; which is the case many times. The Killeen Police Department asks everyone not to leave valuables inside the vehicle and to **LOCK YOUR CAR DOORS!** Don't be a victim and don't make it easy for burglars to take your things.
