The Killeen Police Department Burglary Unit arrested four Killeen men and one male juvenile for burglarizing a residence on Wood St. during which they tied up the elderly male who lived there.

Officers responded to the 1700 block of Wood on Friday, September 17, 2010, at approximately 3:30am, after being told that the resident had been tied up and the house burglarized. Upon their arrival they began talking with the 86 year old male resident who told them several males broke into his residence at approximately 2:30am and threatened him with a knife; they tied him up and rummaged through the house taking several items of value. The victim did not know who the suspects were but did give a description of them to the officers.

During the investigation the Burglary Unit detectives located video evidence that the suspects had used the victim's credit cards at a local store. Through further investigation the detectives were able to identify the suspects. On November 5, 2010 this case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office and complaints were issued charging 18 year old Kenneth Anthony Reed, 18 year old Gregory Duane Brown, 25 year old Jason Michael Colson, and 23 year old Rasheen Jamal Robinson with Aggravated Robbery. A 14 year old male was also identified as a suspect in this Aggravated Robbery. Justice of the Peace Garland Potvin issued warrants for the four adults. Jason Colson was already in the Bell County Jail on another Aggravated Robbery charge and this warrant was served at that time. Reed and Brown were stopped by officers during a traffic violation on Saturday, November 6, 2010 and taken into custody. Robinson was arrested at his place of employment on Tuesday, November 9, 2010. The juvenile has been referred to the Bell County Juvenile Attorney's Office.
