December 24, 2010 - Update

Officers responded to the 1<sup>st</sup> National Bank Texas located at 4304 E. Central Texas Expressway at 5:02pm, after receiving a 911 call advising them that the bank had just been robbed. Upon their arrival the officers were told by witnesses that a black subject (unknown if it is a male or female at this time) who was approximately 5'6" tall and had a slim build, entered the bank and handed the teller a note demanding money. The suspect did not display a weapon but made reference to having one. The suspect then fled the bank on foot eastbound; it is possible there was another person wearing dark clothing with the suspect when they fled.

Shortly after the robbery an officer located two females sitting outside the Hallmark Lanes which is located at 4203 Shawn Dr. and they told him they were waiting for a cab; these two females were detained at that time. After further investigation into the bank robbery, the 19 year old and 23 year old females were taken into custody and transported to the Killeen City Jail.



On Friday, December 24, 2010, the Bell County District Attorney's Office returned four complaints charging 19 year old Jalyssa Shalaine Bradley (left) and 23 year old Amber Denise Waters (right) with two counts of Aggravated Robbery each. One stemming from the 1<sup>st</sup> National Bank Texas robbery and the other stemming from an Aggravated Robbery that occurred on Tuesday, December 22, 2010 at approximately 9:45pm at the Subway



located at 3800 E. Stan Schlueter Loop. Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke set their bonds at \$100,000 each charge; they are currently in the Bell County Jail.
