Killeen Police need your help in locating a 22 year old Killeen man who is wanted for Aggravated Robbery.

This incident occurred on Sunday, January 2, 2011, just after 12:00 noon when the victim came outside of a residence in the 1900 block of Kenyon and found a man breaking into a Chevy Trailblazer 4door, when the man saw the resident he threatened them with a gun and fled in a gold vehicle.

Through the investigation detectives were able to identify the suspect involved in this robbery and had this case reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office. The Bell County District Attorney's Officer returned a complaint charging Barry Leon Bryant Jr. with Aggravated Robbery of an Individual and Justice of the Peace Bill Cooke issued a warrant for his arrest.

Barry Leon Bryant Jr.(also known as "Red") is described as a 22 year old light skinned black male with black hair and brown eyes. He is approximately 5'5" tall and weighs approximately 144 pounds. He has numerous tattoos on his arms and chest. **HE IS CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.**

UPDATE: January 18, 2011

The Killeen Police Department was notified early Sunday, January 16, 2011, that Barry Leon Bryant Jr. was taken into custody by the Hattiesburg, MS Police Department. He was arrested at a residence in Hattiesburg after the US Marshals Office notified them that he was wanted by their office as well as the Killeen Police Department.
