Killeen Police arrested three males after a report of a Burglary had just occurred at 1320 Wales on Tuesday, January 11, 2011.



Officers responded to 1320 Wales (the Hoodview Apartments) at 1:29pm after a resident came home to find his door kicked in and items missing from his apartment. While the resident was inside on the phone to the police, three black male came to the apartment and pushed the door open to find the resident inside. The three males then fled on foot towards Corona Dr. As the officers were enroute to the apartments they were told of the three black males in the area; two detectives



located the three males in the area of Willowsprings and Corona. The officers arrived to assist the detectives and located the stolen items inside a residence located in the 2100 block of Corona Dr. The items were returned to the victim at 1320 Wales Dr. and the three males were taken into custody and transported to the Killeen City Jail.

This case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's Office on Wednesday, January 12, 2011, and a complaint charging 17 year old Terry Allen Davis and 17 year old Jorge Ivan Perez-Calderon both of Killeen, with Burglary of a Habitation. They are currently in the Killeen City Jail awaiting arraignment. The third male was released with no charges.
