Killeen Police need your help in locating an 18 year old Killeen man who is wanted for Credit Card Abuse.

This warrant stems from a burglary of a vehicle that occurred during the early morning hours on November 3, 2010. During the burglary the window was shot out of the car and a purse was stolen from the vehicle. The suspect along with another suspect used a credit card from this stolen purse to purchase cigarettes at a convenience store that same day. Video footage was given and a Crime Stoppers Tip identified the two males who were the suspects involved in using this credit card.

This case was reviewed by the Bell County District Attorney's office on December 15, 2010, and complaints were issued charging 28 year old Joseph Anthony Quinonez and 18 year old David Taylor Coffey with Credit Card Abuse. Justice of the Peace Garland Potvin issued warrants for their arrests. Quinonez was arrested at his residence on December 28, 2010; he was transferred to the Bell County Jail with a \$50,000 bond.

David Taylor Coffey is a white male who is 5'10" tall and weighs approximately 170 pounds.
