"This area should be as natural as possible with lots of shade to get relief from the sun. Play areas for kids with shade. Plant more trees that can survive"

"I really would like a contained area, where my small children get to have freedom to play and move and I can keep an eye on them from where I'm seated. Seating for parents with electric hookups, (backed chairs and benches for older folks), air conditioned bathrooms with changing tables in men's and women's, covered seating and play areas, children's picnic tables, food truck area, bike path loop for lttles where you can watch your kids practice safely and see them the whole time while seated, the Children's Park in Tyler has a nice bowl set up with bike paths, I'd highly recommend a look at."

"I am concerned with flooding in these areas. Please keep that in mind when planning the play areas. Maintaining the amenities is always a concern of mine. Nice things always get broken down if not addressed immediately or consistently policed."

I would like to comment that the smaller zone should include a large size dog park. There are very few options for decent dog parks in Killeen. The ones I have visited so far have not been maintained well and this is a great chance to put in the best dog park Killeen could offer so far."

"What is the name of these new parks? Which pot of money will the funding these parks? What about the donated land by the Stonetree Golf Course, is that park also going to be developed into a place for children to play or have trails for bicycles, walking, etc.?"

"We really need some splash pads on our side of town. The one at the long Branch park is not always working and when it is then it is too packed cause it's so small. A natural type splash pad with rocks like the Quarry Splash Pad in Leander would be perfect. Then we wouldn't always have to drive so far."

While we were stationed in Germany, all the playgrounds had sand boxes and when we moved here my son was so upset that none of the playgrounds here have one. It would be really nice to have a shaded sand box somewhere in town so that my son doesn't have to wait till we go to the beach once a year to be able to use his sand toys. I'm pretty sure I'm not the only parent that thinks this."

## CONT... Questions, Comments, & Concerns

### Responses:

"I am concerned about the upkeep on the parks as it is lacking on the existing parks already in town. I would like to know what security measures will be in place for the citizens utilizing all parks. I personally do not feel safe any longer so I don't go anymore."

"Will there be wildlife protection built into the parks plans? We have an assortment of wildlife life in this neighborhood, coyotes, armadillo, skunks, red tail hawks and we have bats plus many others. Every effort needs to be made to protect our natural habitat."

"Sidewalks/crosswalks around perimeters of parks- ADA accessible. Would there be anyone monitoring the crime or homeless community being in here?"

"Please consider all of the above. Even if some at a time then expanding we desperately need a park in west killeen. Lions is often hard to get to distance traffic and can be crowded. These will allow us to walk or bike to enjoy the outdoors with our neighbors and friends. Thank you!!"

"The cost how much are taxes going to be"

"Any enforcement between homes right next to park?"

"Estimated time of completion?"

"Please ensure there is plenty of lighting, I foresee these areas being used in criminal activity. Ensure plenty of garbage/ recycle bins placed. Do this right if your going to spend tax payer dollars."

"I'm not asking for a huge parking lot but 3 parking spaces would be great."

"What happened to the park by Watercrest Rd?"

"I believe the City has an opportunity to have two distinct park areas that should be left in their natural state. Adding minimalistic features would be the best fit in these areas. Accessibility should also be considered for path areas. We are running out of natural areas and these sites should be allowed to remain as untouched as we can safely allow"

The community repeatedly had to rally together to put out fires set by the teenagers who patronized this area. Creating a park will only increase road traffic and encourage patronage during quiet hours. The community did not ask for a park. We asked for speed bumps and more police presence to control excessive speeding and petty crime in this area."


