## JUROR'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Important: Please read carefully all information included in these forms. This court hears cases alleging violations of traffic laws and other Class C misdemeanors; trials are generally concluded within one day. Answer all questions on the Juror Questionnaire located on the back of this document. PRINT LEGIBLY. You are to appear promptly as instructed by this summons. If you have a special need or disability you are encouraged to notify the Court immediately concerning requests for reasonable accommodation. DO NOT CONTACT THE COURT TO INQUIRE IF YOU MUST APPEAR FOR JURY DUTY. One day prior to your report date check the court's website www.killeentexas.gov to confirm if you are required to report. Click the Departments tab and select Municipal Court. Jury reporting information will be displayed in the second paragraph from the top directly under the "Mission" paragraph. If your report date and time is listed you will be required to appear.

**Right to Reemployment:** A private employer may not terminate the employment of a permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror. An employee whose employment is terminated in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return. (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001). Terminating an employee for performing jury duty is punishable by up to 180 days in jail and/or a fine not to exceed \$2,000 (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.002).

Failure to Answer Summons and Penalties: Any person summoned who fails to attend or who fails to remain in attendance until discharged by the Court may be fined an amount not to exceed \$100 for contempt (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 45.027). Additionally, a person shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 if the person: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to the notice without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service (Government Code, Section 62.111). Furthermore, if a person knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption to be excused from jury service, the person is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine not less than \$100 or more than \$1,000 (Government Code, Section 62.0140).

<u>Proper Clothing Required</u>: All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonably befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings. Shorts and T-shirts are not appropriate or permitted.

**EXEMPT OR DISQUALIFIED:** You do not need to appear in person if you are exempt or not qualified for jury service. To claim an exemption or report your disqualification **you must complete the form on the back of this page, sign it, and deliver it to the Court through one of the methods listed in the box at the upper-right corner of this page.** Note: If you claim to be disqualified based on a lack of U.S. citizenship, you will no longer be eligible to vote if you fail to provide proof of citizenship. Further, if you claim to be disqualified based on lack of residence in this county, you may no longer be able to vote in this county.
