## What is Impervious Cover?

⇒ Impervious cover includes surfaces that do not let rainfall absorb into the soil. Some examples of impervious cover rooftops, driveways, walkways, patios, sheds, parking lots, and loading docks.



## How can I reduce my Impervious Cover?

⇒ Non-residential customers can reduce the amount of impervious cover by

1. Removing impervious cover.
2. Installing voluntary stormwater best management practices ( i.e. those that are not required for development).
