



VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Join the team and volunteer with the City of Killeen Parks and Recreation Department. We offer a variety of volunteer opportunities for ages 16 and up. These include volunteering, teaching, and coaching for programs, classes, leagues, events and environmental cleanup days throughout our Parks, Recreation, Athletics, Senior Center, and Events Divisions. For those 4th grade – 12th grade we offer volunteer opportunities through the Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) and Jr. Youth Advisory Commission (Jr. YAC).

How do I become a volunteer?

You must first fill and submit the online form found online at <https://www.killeentexas.gov/Volunteers> at the bottom of the page. Fill out appropriately and submit the form electronically.

How do I become a member of the Youth Advisory Commission?

You must first fill out the Youth Advisory Commissioner application found online at <http://www.killeentexas.gov/YACApp>.

Once you pass the background check you will be notified and can begin volunteering.

How long does it take to pass the background check?

It can take up to 2 weeks to pass the background check.

How will I know if I am approved to volunteer?

The department that you requested to volunteer for will contact you via e-mail or phone.

I want to volunteer, but I don't know how to do anything.

Don't worry! We accept all volunteers with all skills and abilities. There will be a volunteer orientation teaching how and what to do.

How long is my background check valid?

Volunteer background checks are valid for 365 days from the date of approval
