Rules and Regulations

- 1. Refunds are not given for admission tickets.**
- 2. Pets are not allowed in the facility.**
- 3. No horseplay, including but not limited to: running, riding on shoulders, rough housing, etc.**
- 4. No gum allowed in facility.**
- 5. No alcohol or glass containers allowed in facility.**
- 6. No outside food or drinks allowed in the facility, with the exception of water and infant formula.**
- 7. Family friendly swimsuits mandatory. No thong swimsuits, cotton material, or basketball shorts allowed.**
- 8. Children in a life jacket must be within an arm's length of a parent/guardian at all times.**
- 9. Children less than 48" must be within arm's length of a parent/guardian at all times.**
- 10. Children who wear diapers are required to wear a swim diaper while in the pool.**
- 11. No smoking/vaping allowed inside or within 15 feet of the building.**
- 12. No glass allowed (this includes tempered glass goggles).**
- 13. No water guns, water toys, or floatation devices allowed in the park.**
- 14. All bags are subject to search.**
- 15. Staff reserves the right to refuse service.**

Proper swim attire must be worn whenever enjoying a City of Killeen public pool. Proper swim attire is defined as family friendly articles of clothing made of materials designed for use in the water. If you have any questions regarding what is or is not considered proper swim attire, please seek the assistance of an aquatics team member.

Swim wear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal ornamentation are not allowed in the water. Underwear is not allowed. Thong bikinis, revealing swimwear and see through attire are prohibited. Lifeguard apparel is also not allowed in any City of Killeen public pool facility, outside of that worn by staff.

Cover-ups for modesty or sun protection may be worn in addition to proper swim attire, with the exception of cotton material.
