In addition to review and recommendations on an Industrial Stormwater Sources Ordinance, the Stakeholder's Group will be utilized to review and make recommendations on the City's Illicit Discharge, Erosion & Sediment Control, Post Construction, Special Flood Hazard Area, and Development Ordinances.</p>
